PATRICK BAUDOIN AND THE TERROIRS OF ANJOU

Patrick Baudouin returned to his family's vineyards in the Côteaux du Layon after trying his hand at a few things, before figuring out his true calling was making the vineyards and heritage of his forebears speak. Organic farming and non-interventionist winemaking allows the character of the different vineyards he farms to truly express themselves. He vinifies five different Anjou Chenin Blancs from 6 separate sites. All are aged in mostly used Burgundian barrels, and all for between 10 to 14 months.

Anjou, *Effusion*, 2021 \$65
From 2 parcels. Shale, sandstone, and silica soils. Pineapple, quince, and rocks. Lively acidity throughout.

Anjou, *Les Braundières*, 2019 \$102
A dry wine made from a vineyard in Coteaux du Layon. Shallow sandstone-schist soils. Textured and layered with notes of honey, spice and orchard fruits.

Anjou, *Les Saulaies*, 2007 \$135
A north facing vineyard with 100 year-old vines! There is lots of quartz mixed in with the schist. An example of a perfectly aged Chenin that is drinking at its prime.

CHABLIS

Lovers of Chablis rejoice in finding one that is truly titular - that could be nothing else. While made with chardonnay and part of the larger Burgundy region there is something different about Chablis. The eponymous town is 85 miles NW of Dijon, the largest town of the Côte d'Or.

The unique mix of the soil in each vineyard - how much chalky limestone to clay and fossilized seashells - and subtle differences in exposition are what makes each of Chablis vineyards' wines so distinct from the next. The wines that follow are all chardonnay.... all Chablis... and we love them.

OREGON CHARDONNAY

The quality of Willamette Valley Pinot Noir is long established and draws frequent comparisons to Burgundy. However, it has taken a few decades for Burgundy's main white grape, Chardonnay, to join Pinot in the spotlight. Some say that in the past growers had the wrong clones of chard planted, or that the best vineyards and plots were planted to Pinot. The circumstances have changed and many winemakers are devoting as much attention to Chardonnay as their Pinot Noirs - or more! These are some that showcase what Chard can do here.

IN BETWEEN WINES

Rosé and orange wines live in the middle - they aren't quite red or white - so that's where we put them.

Rosé comes from red grapes and incorporates some of the color from the skin, but not enough to qualify as a red wine. Orange wines, also known as skin-contact wines, are simply wines made by leaving the grape skin in contact with the juice from white grapes. The flavor profiles are in a league all of their own displaying structure, tannin and texture. Orange wine may just spark a new fire in your wine game. Ya welcome.

BURGUNDY

CHARLES LACHAUX & DOMAINE ARNOUX-LACHAUX

Charles Lachaux is a vigneron with vision, and is not one to rest on his, or his family domain's laurels. He pushes the envelope and challenges the status quo, all with the goal of delicious Burgundy in mind. In the vineyard he takes a regenerative approach to farming. Plantings are dense, vines are not hedged, the rows are not mowed or tilled. In the winery whole cluster fermentation is employed, oak is limited (and being phased out), macerations are short, punch downs are few, and sulphur is extremely limited. All of this is to bring the terroir and the grape front and center in the wine with the maximum amount of energy and vibrancy.

The Charles Lachaux wines, as opposed to those from Domaine Arnoux-Lachaux, were first made in 2018 with domaine aligoté purchased by Charles to make under this micro-negoce label along with some prized parcels from friends farming with similar techniques and farming goals in mind. The wines see a 12 month elevage, as opposed to the the domaine's 18, but are otherwise made quite the same. The wines have been coveted by restaurants and collectors since the very first release and often sell for many many times their intended price – into the 4 figure realm. We are excited to offer this selection of the 2021's here.

In Comblanchien, this lieu-dit is located at the top of the slope, facing east. White stony soils over limestone bedrock.

Nuits-St.-Georges, *Le Petite Charmotte*, 2021 \$599
Northern side of Nuits-St-Georges, beneath 1er Cru Boussselot. Gentle slope, eastern exposure.

Aloxe-Corton, *1er Cru Les Valozières*, 2021 \$775
Northern side of Valozières, beneath Corton Bressandes, east-facing. Rich clay soils.

DOMAINE JEAN-LOUIS CHAVE:CLOS FLORENTIN

The Chave family domaine was founded in 1481, and the current proprietor, Jean-Louis, represents the 16 th generation of the Chave family run the domaine. Most people associate the domaine with Hermitage, and for very good reason. However, the first parcels of vineyards the Chaves farmed back in the 15 th century were in Saint-Joseph. Since taking over the domaine in 1993, Jean-Louis has made it his life's work to re-built, re-plant, and re-terrace the family's holdings in Saint-Joseph. This Clos Florentin though is something different. Where the rest of the Domaine's holdings in St. Joseph lie in the terraced hillsides at the heart of the appellation, the Clos Florentin is flatter, west of the heart of Mauves, closer to the river. The Chaves purchased it from the Florentin family in 2009. The Florentin domaine was founded by a doctor and philosopher as a place of refuge and contemplation, and encompasses gardens, orchards, a small amphitheater for concerts, and the Clos de l'Arbelestrier, which is made up of 90-year-old Syrah vines that have never seen any chemical inputs. As Jean-Louis rehabilitated the vineyard the grapes went into the other Saint Joseph bottling, until he felt it was ready to be bottled on its own. The wine is refined, deep, and pure, perhaps more contemplative than many Saint Joseph. It is a rare bird, not to be missed!

CHÂTEAU DE BEUCASTEL CHÂTEAUNEUF DU PAPE

Vines have been grown at Beaucastel since the sixteenth century, but the modern history of the château begins when the Perrin family took over the 110-hectare estate in the early 1900s. In the 1960s when most winegrowers in France were adopting synthetic fertilizers and pesticides the Perrin family chose to embrace organic farming methods. They now benefit from old vines with root systems that dig deep past the galets roulés and into the clay and limestone below. Beaucastel is one of the few producers who still grow and use all 13 permitted grape varieties in their wines, and are known as well for the high percentage of Mourvèdre in the blend.

LITTORAI

When Ted Lemon returned from Burgundy in the early 90s (where he was the winemaker at Domaine Roulot-which was a major coup to have an young American leading up that venerable domaine!), he and his wife Heidi began searching for a place on the west coast to make *terroir*-expressive Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. They chose the cool climate of the Sonoma Coast. In fact, Littorai is Latin for "the coasts". Their Gold Ridge estate, home to the Pivot Vineyard, is the realization of their theory of "generative" agriculture. The goal is to have a healing relationship with nature rather than an exploitative one and provide a net ecological gain when farming. In addition to wines from the Pivot Vineyard, they have some long-term partnerships with other growers including Savoy Vineyard which is an organically farmed site in the foothills of the Anderson Valley. Our favorite thing about the Littorai wines is that they are as delicious as they are complex - They make it hard to put your glass down!

COOL-CLIMATE CALIFORNIA: PHELAN FARM

The Phelan family has lived on their property nestled alongside Steiner Creek since 1851. In 2007 Greg Phelan started planting vines on their own roots. It was ten years later when he met sommelier and author Rajat Parr that the grape growing experiment he started years earlier really began to take its unique shape. The San Luis Obispo AVA where Phelan Farm is located has the coolest climate of any growing region in California - you don't go to Cambria to lie on the beach and get a tan!

Raj saw the potential for the site to express its terroir through cool climate grape varieties from regions like Jura and the Savoie, and vines were grafted over to these varieties. The vineyards are farmed regeneratively with the goal of creating a sustainable ecosystem that can be passed on to future generations. They spray ferments from native plants instead of copper and sulfur and fertilize with manure from goats and chickens that live on the property. The vineyard has never been tilled which allows the complex microbial network within the soil to flourish. Fermentations are carried out using native yeasts without any sulfur additions. These wines are a singular and transparent expression of the place they were grown and are not to be missed!
